The Prayer Shawl Ministry at Souderton Mennonite Church is trying to warm up our little corner of the world and we need your help. We are knitting and crocheting blocks that we will stitch together to make blankets. The finished blankets will be donated to Keystone Opportunity Center in Souderton and Urban Promise in Camden, New Jersey.

You can help make the 7" x 9" blocks with us! Knit or crochet a block in a stitch/gauge that provides warmth (i.e., not lacey) and in any color you like — just make it 7" x 9" in size. Then give the blocks to Joy Good, Susan Long, Dee Johnson, or at the Church Office. If you would like a template so you don't have to measure, just ask the women listed above.

This is an ongoing project for the Prayer Shawl Ministry and we could really use your help. You can make the blocks at home as you have time, or join us at our Prayer Shawl meetings on the first Tuesday of each month, September - May, from 7 to 8:30 p.m. in the Fellowship Hall Lobby.

If you've never knitted or crocheted but want to learn, come to a Prayer Shawl meeting and we'll teach you how!

You're also welcome to make Prayer Shawls with us at our monthly meetings or own your own. Ask any of the women listed above for the pattern. The prayer shawls are given to people going through difficult times, such as the loss of a loved one or a serious illness.

The more blocks we make, the more people we keep warm!
